

1. Call to Order and Establishment of a Quorum

There were 19 full members present, the meeting was therefore declared quorate.

2. Apologies for Absence

Richard Clayton, Ben Constable, Anja Newman and Fergus O'Sullivan.

3. Minutes of AGM held 24th February 2019

The Minutes were presented and approved. Proposed by Rob Turvil, seconded by Richard Biggs, carried unanimously.

5. Officers' Reports

- a) *Commodore:* Tony Tye, Commodore 2019-2020, gave the report to the meeting. (Copy of report on club website).
- b) Membership Secretary: Membership levels have been relatively steady over the year, bucking the trend of many small clubs. Although we have had several resignations from inactive members in the last year, we have seen 15 new members join, most of whom have been actively participating in club activities, both on and off the water. We currently have 77 active and paid memberships, (43 Family, 27 Individual, 2 Individual & Junior, 2 Social & Junior and 3 Honorary). Our Winter membership has proved popular with visitors, particularly the Phantom class.

The Committee has carried out a review to make the membership offering more streamlined and fitting to current water sports interests, with a view to further increasing activity at the club. There has been increased interest in kayaking and paddleboarding, and last year we trialled group membership for Tendring Canoe Club which has been successful.

c) Treasurer: Another good year was reported. Total income for the year ending 30th September 2019 increased by 4% to £28,512. Cash at the bank and in hand totalled £47,299, (down by £3,252 on previous year). During the year the club spent £8,000 on a new patio and a further £1,270 on kayaks and paddleboards. Overall, the club made an annual loss of £4,806, (compared to a surplus of £4,063 in the previous year). The club boats now include Lasers, a Topper, kayaks and paddleboards as well as the existing fleet of Argos, Picos and a Tera.

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6. Approval of Accounts for year ending 30th September 2019

The Accounts were approved. Proposed John Thompson, seconded Steve Ede, carried unanimously.

7. Reappointment of Auditors

Independent Examiners Ltd was reappointed. Proposed Rob Turvil, seconded Steve Ede, carried unanimously.
